Cedar Bend Lodge #583 F&AM is pleased to offer an opportunity for a scholarship to a deserving high school senior in the Rainbow City/Southside area or a student whose father or grandfather is a member of Cedar Bend Lodge #583 or who is a child or grandchild of Coosa Valley Chapter #551 OES (Order of Eastern Star) member, regardless of the student's residence. This scholarship award will be for **One Thousand Dollars** (\$1,000) and will be awarded based on need, community involvement and academics. A committee of five members of Cedar Bend Lodge #583 will select the student who receives this scholarship. Applications may be picked up in the school counselor's office and must be turned in to the school counselor (or in the case of a member's child or grandchild, sent to the Lodge) and received by the Lodge, **prior to April 1, 2014**. Applications received, regardless of the postmark, after April 1, 2014, will not receive consideration. **Please pay attention to the following rules:**

1. Scholarship may be used for tuition at an acceptable accredited university, college or vocational/trade school.
2. Grade point average must be high enough to be admitted to the school/college chosen.
3. Lodge will pay the scholarship money directly to the school.
4. If the student drops out of school, any refund must be returned to Cedar Bend Lodge #583 by the school.
5. Applicant must live within the Rainbow City/Southside, area or be a child or grandchild of a Cedar Bend Lodge or Coosa Valley Chapter #551 OES member.
6. A current copy of the student's transcript **MUST** accompany the application.
